

## **Frequently Asked Questions Sea Ventures Summer Camps 2010**

### **Can my children attend at the same time?**

Due to space restrictions The Living Planet Aquarium (TLPA) is unable to offer our summer camps simultaneously. So if you have children of different ages they will be unable to attend summer camps together.

### **How do I choose the right summer camp?**

Please choose the camp that correlates with the grade level that your child just completed in the 2009-2010 school year. TLPA reserves the right to move or cancel the registration of campers that have signed up for camps that do not match their grade level.

### **Can my child go into a different age group?**

In order to give your child the best camp experience possible all campers must be within the same age range.

### **When does registration Begin/End?**

Registration is open now! Registration ends when the camp is full or two weeks prior to the first day of camp. Registration is not complete until payment has been made in full.

### **What is the cost?**

Preschool camps are \$50 for Non-members and \$45 for Members. A parent/guardian is welcome to attend with this age at no additional cost.

Kindergarten Graduates through 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduate camps are \$55 for Non-members and \$50 for Members.

Extreme Eaters camp for 7<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduates is \$155 for Non-members and \$145 for Members.

Marine Biologists in Training camp is \$240 for Non-members and \$225 for Members.

### **Does the cost include a T-shirt?**

Each camper will receive a 2010 Sea Ventures Camp T-shirt on the first day of camp for no additional charge.

### **Why are the camps different prices?**

Prices are based on the length of time that the camp runs.

### **How do I pay for camp?**

TLPA accepts Cash, Debit and Credit cards with the Visa, Master Card or American Express logo.

### **What is your Cancellation Policy?**

No refunds will be given for cancellations made less than two weeks prior to the first day of camp. A 75% refund will be given for cancellations made prior to two weeks before the camp start date. In the unlikely event TLPA must cancel a camp; registrants will be granted a full refund.

### **What time does camp start?**

All camps start at 8:30 am.

### **What do I need to bring with me the day of camp?**

Driver's License or another State Issued Picture ID, this will be required to drop-off and pick-up your camper.

Please have your child wear their camp T-shirt every day of camp.

We also recommend bringing a re-usable water bottle, but this is not required.

**When can my child be dropped off?**

Please arrive on time to check your camper in and out of camp. Campers may be dropped off no more than 10 minutes early and must be picked up no more than 10 minutes after camp ends. Early drop-offs and late pick-ups will be charged a \$10 fee.

**Will food be provided?**

During all of our day camps, campers will be provided with a supervised space to eat a lunch and drink that they bring from home. TLPA will also provide a snack. Full day campers are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle from home to carry with them. If your child has special nutritional needs or allergies, please note those needs on the Camper Information Form.

**Can I stay with my child during camp?**

Parents of Preschool campers are welcome to attend camp with their child. Other camper's parents will not be allowed to attend camp with their child unless they would like to pay the full camp fee.
