Loveland Living Planet Aquarium a highlight at Sundance Film Festival

The Loveland Living Planet Aquarium will be participating in the 2014 Independent Film Makers Lounge, #IndieLounge, at The Sundance Film Festival in Park City. The aquarium is excited to expand relationships into the film industry and hopes to be recognized as a film site and screening venue for filmmakers worldwide. The Film Makers Lounge has rapidly become one of the most popular lounges during the Festival. The aquarium decided to partner with the Indie Lounge because they cater to film industry professionals, directors, producers, studio executives and celebrities.

Daniel Thompson, with Power & Industry, and organizer of the Indie Lounge says, "We are thrilled to have the Loveland Living Planet Aquarium be a part of our lounge. We are known for having the most unique and exclusive venues and now that will include the new aquarium. Utah Governor Gary Herbert will be stopping by the lounge on Saturday. Some of the aquarium's favorite animals will also be making an appearance Friday and Saturday.

The Loveland Living Planet Aquarium has Utah's only 4D theater. It can accommodate up to 156 guests, and has sensory effects including wind, mist and movement. The aquarium can also serve as a filming location and host special events. The entire venue can accommodate a 2,000 person fully catered event, and there is a 450 seat banquet room with full service catering, and

a floor to ceiling window into the shark tank. The new aquarium is a 501c(3) nonprofit organization. It will be 136,000 square feet and will house over 5,000 animals from around the world's oceans, rain forests and rivers. Its mission is to inspire guests to explore, discover and learn about our Living Planet.
