## Waddle your way to Penguin Awareness Day at Loveland Living Planet Aquarium

Did you know Gentoo penguins are the world's fastest swimming bird, reaching speeds of up to 22 miles per hour? Did you know the Little blue penguin is the smallest of the penguin species, standing only about one foot tall? Or that Emperor penguins can dive down 1,800 feet and hold their breath for 22 minutes?

The Aquarium is teaching guests all about penguins during Penguin Awareness week from January 18<sup>th</sup> through the 24<sup>th</sup>! Guests can go on a scavenger hunt to learn about penguins of the world, and earn a special penguin button for completing the game. Visitors can also watch a Penguin Feeding every day at 4pm.

The Aquarium is also partnering with Mountain America Credit Union to name the last baby penguin! We had five baby penguins born this summer. Four of them are named. Our only girl is named Ava, and the others are Uno, Scamper and Airn (pronounced Aaron). We are running a Facebook contest currently to name the last one, a boy, born on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. His name will be announced on Saturday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>.

We invite the media to join us on National Penguin Awareness Day, January 20<sup>th</sup>. Members of the media will be given the opportunity to meet our penguins up close and get the chance to feed them at 1pm (meeting the penguins will be accommodated at 1pm only. Please don't be late if you want to film them up close). Then, stick around to see our divers swim in the frigid waters of the penguin exhibit.
