

Climbing Spider Craft

Supplies:

- Construction paper
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Markers, coloring pencils, etc.
- Straw (paper or plastic)
- Tape
- Glue
- Scissors
- String or yarn, thread, etc.



Procedure:

1. Start with creating an oval or a circle and 8 legs from your construction paper. You can also print out an image of a spider to color in if you'd like.
2. Next, you'll glue the legs on either side of the body.
3. Once the glue has dried, flip the construction paper spider over and add on any decorations such as googly eyes or draw on a face!
4. Cut a long piece of string/yarn. You can make your string as long as you want, however, the spider will only climb as far as you can pull the strings apart.
5. You can use a small piece of tape to create a "needle" on one end of the string so it's easier to pull through the straw.
6. Once the string is threaded through both straws, you can glue the straws down to the back of the spider and tape to secure it in place.
7. Tie both ends of the string together in a knot. Hang the string (the tied together part) on a door knob or anywhere really, and pull the loose ends apart to make the spider go up and back together to make it go down.
