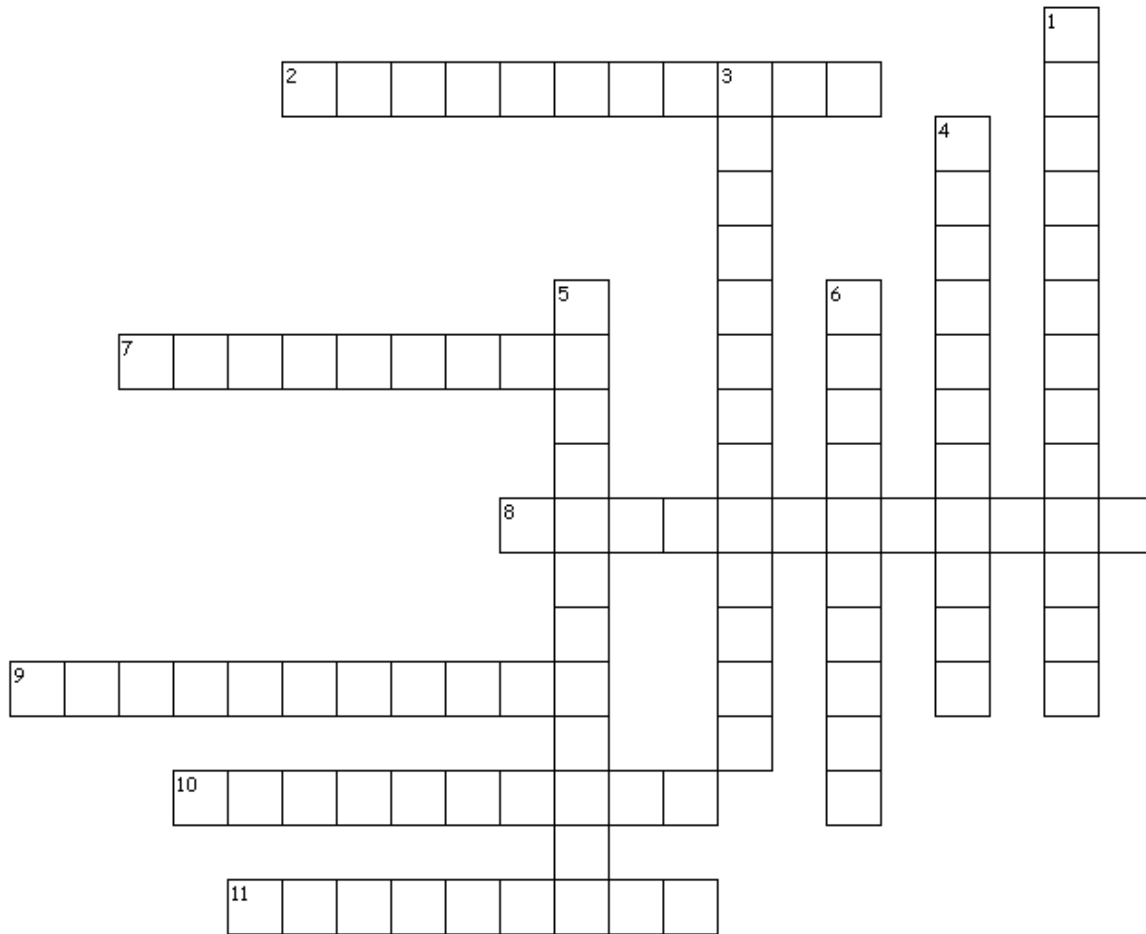


LLPA Snakes Crossword Puzzle



ACROSS:

2. This rattle-snake-mimic makes its home in the burrows of gophers
7. It might scare you with its red, black, and yellow coloration, but this non-venomous constrictor is royalty.
8. This python has a pattern resembling something soft and made of fibers on the floor in a house.
9. You may see this snake in people's gardens, but don't let its nickname confuse you. This snake was named after a band worn around the leg to keep up a stocking.
10. If you follow this boa to its end, you might just find a pot of gold. Named after the prismatic affects of its scales.
11. This snake has green camouflage that helps it to look like the thin climbing plants from which it gets its name.

DOWN:

1. This snake species is considered the heaviest in the world
3. This boa lives high up in the TREES of the AMAZON rain forest.
4. This python gets its name from the red colored scales on its body that reminded scientists of a fluid in the human body.
5. This boa has red scales on its tail
6. This snake curls itself into a ball to protect its head when threatened.
